SPEAKERS AND PRESENTATIONS

Caleb Bupp, M.D.: The Power of Genetic Testing – Tales from the Clinic

Caleb Bupp, MD, FACMG is a board certified pediatrician and medical geneticist practicing with Spectrum Health in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He is also a clinical assistant professor for Michigan State University and the chairperson of the Genomics Committee at Helen DeVos Children's Hospital. He did his pediatrics residency at the University of Louisville and his genetics training at the Greenwood Genetic Center in South Carolina. His clinical interests include intellectual disability, genetics education, and rare syndromes. He has authored multiple journal articles and textbook chapters in the field of genetics and has been an invited speaker for many conferences and events locally and nationally.

Dennis Campbell, Ph.D.: Cri du Chat 101

Associate Professor of Special Education at the University of South Alabama. **Dr. Dennis Campbell** is the parent of a Young adult, Amy, with 5p- Syndrome. He chairs the Professional Advisory Board for the 5P Minus Society and has worked with many other parent support groups. He chairs the Human rights committee which reviews, and approves rights restrictions for several of the local agencies that serve individuals with cognitive and intellectual disabilities as well as mental illness. He has researched, published and presented extensively regarding Cri-du-Chat Syndrome, disability advocacy, and transition. Dennis was named Parent of the Year in 2014 with his beautiful wife Shari.

Mary Ann Ehlert, Protected Tomorrows: Journey Through an Eight Step Special Needs Planning Program and ABLE Act information

Our founder, **Mary Anne Ehlert,** CFP, had a successful career in the financial industry when she decided to act on her lifelong desire to specialize in serving the families of the disabled. The source of her inspiration was very dear to her heart. Mary Anne herself had come from such a family. Her younger sister, Marcia, to whom she felt especially close, suffered severe mental handicaps due to cerebral palsy. Although their parents were naturally determined that Marcia should get the best possible care, they had also been understandably confused how best to plan and provide for her future.

Scott Faber, M.D.: Nutritional Deficiency and Immune Dysregulation in a Child with 5p- Syndrome

Scott Faber, MD, is a developmental pediatrician at The Children's Institute, working with children with severe developmental and behavioral disorders, including autism. Dr. Faber previously served for six years as director of Developmental-Behavioral Pediatrics at Mercy Hospital in Pittsburgh.

Dr. Faber is a frequent lecturer and has made presentations at national American Academy of Pediatrics exhibitions and at Pediatric Academic Society meetings. In addition, he has published works on the clinical effects of deprivation on the developing brain as well as other topics.

Erin Gilsbach, Esq.: Transition: Life After High School and a Review of Special Ed Federal Law

An experienced speaker at the state and national levels on current trends and important issues regarding school law and education, Erin Gilsbach is the Director of Professional and Policy Development and an attorney with the PA-based law firm of King Spry Herman Freund & Faul. She is a founding member of the Greyfriars Institute, a nonprofit affiliate entity dedicated to providing quality professional education in the area of school law to educators and school leaders.

Intervention Fundamentals: Learning to Sleep and Toilet Training

Intervention Fundamentals was formed in 2014 to provide high-intensity outcome-based training to parents of children with autism and other developmental disabilities. Our interventions target essential skill development in four functional areas: toilet training, communication, feeding, and sleeping. While we specialize in serving families whose children have struggled to achieve functional independence within the context of conventional supports, we also have worked with families whose children have only recently received a diagnosis. No matter what their age, the skills families and their children acquire during our intensive training provide a positive foundation for future learning and skill development.

Shanida Matheiu: Understanding the IEP Process

Shanida Mathieu is the mother of a teen with Cri-du-chat Syndrome. She works with families of children with disabilities, helping them advocate for appropriate educational services for their children and finding community resources to meet their children's needs. She presents parent and professional workshops on a variety of special education topics. As an education advocate for Louisiana's federally funded parent training and information center, under the National consortium of parent training centers, Shanida has trained over 3000 parents and professionals within her state, empowering them to effectively advocate for appropriate services for students with disabilities over the last six years. Shanida has trained under some of the leading experts on special education law.

Kent Nicholls: New Family Orientation

Like you, **Kent Nicholls** is the parent of a child with 5p- and is always searching for information and resources to help his daughter live a better life. As the founder of the 5p- Society, Kent has participated in every 5p- Society Annual Conference and has helped families connect, provide mutual support, and learn from each other. Kent currently serves on the 5p- Society Board of Directors and is chairman of the Strategic Planning Committee.

Katherine O'Neil: Anat Baniel Method NeuroMovement

Katherine (Kathy) O'Neil is an experienced Anat Baniel Method (ABM) for Children NeuroMovement Practitioner. ABM NeuroMovement is a systematic approach to communicating with the brain through its primary language - movement – that awakens the remarkable capacity of the brain to create new connections and new possibilities regardless of the developmental or neurological difficulties.

Kathy has a degree in Early Childhood Education and the Montessori Method from Pennsylvania State University. She began her studies personally with Anat Baniel after the birth of her granddaughter with a rare brain disorder in 2004. She has completed advanced mastery trainings for Children with Special Needs, Vitality and Anti Aging, and High Performers. She is also certified in the Feldenkrais Method.

AmySue Reilly, Ph.D.: Effective Positive Behavior Modification

Dr. AmySue Reilly is the Associate Professor of Special Education, Rehabilitation and Counseling at Auburn University, Dr. Reilly is a member of the Professional Advisory Committee for the 5P Minus Society. She has presented at the past 12 conferences on Behavior Modification. She has also researched and published along with Dr. Campbell regarding Cri-du-Chat Syndrome, disability advocacy and transition. Dr. Reilly was named 2014 Super Hero of the Decade! Because of Dr. Reilly's continued support of the 5p- Society, the Hospitality Suite has been renamed AmySue's Place in her honor.

Matthew Sousa: The Power of Friendship

Matthew Sousa is the Pennsylvania State Director of Best Buddies, based in Pittsburgh, PA. Matthew began his career at the Walt Disney Company where he led marketing and guest relations teams. He then made the jump to the non-profit sector working in various roles at the American Cancer Society, the Muscular Dystrophy Association, and then as the National Director of Development with CureSearch for Children's Cancer. In 2014, Matthew and his partner moved to the UK where he consulted for various charities on strategic planning and development practices.

In 2016, Matthew moved to Pittsburgh and took on the role of State Director, leading one of the largest Best Buddies programs in the country. With more than 6000 participants statewide and over 2500 Buddy pairs, the mission of inclusion at Best Buddies Pennsylvania is now more active than ever. A large part of Matthew's role is ensuring sustainable revenue and income development for the organization – which led him to develop an event that works with local chefs – pairing them with a person with an intellectual/developmental disability. This event brought chef Derek Stevens into the Best Buddies family and has introduced the Best Buddies team to the amazing work of 5P-.

Justin Valenti: Living with Cri du Chat Syndrome – My Perspective

Justin Valenti is a 21-year-old young man with Cri du Chat Syndrome. He currently lives in Gaithersburg, Maryland. Justin likes digital art, movies, books, music, sports, and dogs.
