Dr. AmySue Reilly is the Associate Professor of Special Education, Rehabilitation and Counseling at Auburn University. Dr. Reilly is a member of the Professional Advisory Committee for the 5P Minus Society. She has presented at the past 11 conferences on Behavior Modification. She has also researched and published along with Dr. Campbell regarding Cri-du-Chat Syndrome, disability advocacy and transition. Dr. Reilly was named 2014 Super Hero of the Decade! Because of Dr. Reilly's continued support of the 5p- Society, the Hospitality Suite has been renamed AmySue's Place in her honor.

* **Dr. Jennifer Rosinia - Sensory Processing Disorder**

Jennifer Rosinia is a Registered Occupational Therapist with nearly 30 years experience in pediatrics. A specialist in serving the needs of children birth to age three and their families, she also has extensive experience in working with children ages three to twenty one years. Jennifer earned a Masters degree in Early Childhood Education and a Doctorate in Child Development from Loyola University and the Erikson Institute in Chicago, Illinois. A master clinician and a gifted teacher, Dr. Rosinia has a special interest in sensory processing and neuroscience, the role of emotions and the impact of relationships on the developing child. Shanida has trained under some of the leading experts on special education law.

* **Lisa Juliar - Using Technology as a Life Tool**

Lisa Juliar believes every life experience is an opportunity to learn and grow. Through her own life experiences she founded freed2be therAPPy in 2010 as a way to help others innovatively use the iPad as a "life tool." In October 2013, she was honored to co-present with the developers of Proloquo2go at the Closing the Gap Conference, challenging educators to teach creatively and passionately via technology. Lisa's greatest experiences have been through raising her 4 kids. Cooper (age 12) is the youngest, has Cri du Chat Syndrome and is the reason her heart turned toward starting her business. Some of Lisa's other experiences include working as an Occupational Therapist (before having kids), home educating her 3 oldest children, an adverse medical event, working with the state to provide coverage for iPads and speaking nationally. Lisa's passion is to use her stories to impact positive changes in education, healthcare and homes.

* **Jennifer Eggert - Take a Deep Breath: Respiratory Support for Sound Production**

Jennifer Marie Eggert, MS, CCC-SLP, C/NDT is a Speech Language Pathologist for the Milwaukee Center For Independence's (MCFI) Children's Programs providing services for patients in MCFI's Pediatric Skilled Nursing Program (PSN) in addition to home-based services with the Birth-to-Three team. Jennifer received her Master's Degree from UW-Milwaukee in 1999 and has spent her entire career providing evaluation and treatment for infants, toddlers, preschool and school age children with a variety of diagnoses. Jennifer's focus has consistently been in the area of oral-motor/feeding disorders. She has extensive experience with medically involved children in the Birth-to-Three, Outpatient and Home Health (Post NICU) settings in addition to years of experience as an instructor for the University of Wisconsin system where she taught a variety of undergraduate and graduate level courses in addition to providing both on and off campus student supervision. Jennifer is certified in Neuro-muscular Electrical Stimulation (NMES), received Sequential Oral Sensory (SOS) training in 2008 and is a certified Neurodevelopmental (NDT) therapist. Our founder, **Mary Anne Ehlert**, CFP, had a successful career in the financial industry when she decided to act on her lifelong desire to specialize in serving the families of the disabled. Her younger sister, Marcia, to whom she felt especially close, suffered severe mental handicaps due to cerebral palsy. * **Dr. Alfonso Martinez and Dr. Joan Arvedson - GI Issues and Cri du Chat Syndrome**

Alfonso Martinez, MD is a Gastroenterologist at Children's Hospital of Wisconsin. He has seen several patients with Cri du Chat Syndrome, including all three of the host families children. His areas of interest are enteral feeding tubes, failure to thrive, feeding disorders, Gastroenterology, reflux and reflux disease and nutrition.

Dr. Joan Arvedson is Program Coordinator of Feeding and Swallowing Services at the Children's Hospital of Wisconsin – Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She is Clinical Professor in the Division of Gastroenterology, Department of Pediatrics, Medical College of Wisconsin. Dr. Arvedson received her BS, MS, and PhD degrees from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. She has three books in publication: Interpretation of Videofluoroscopic Swallow Studies of Infants and Children: A Study Guide to Improve Diagnostic Skills and Treatment Planning, 2007; Pediatric Swallowing and Feeding: Assessment and Management, 2nd edition, 2002 (with L. Brodsky, MD) and Pediatric Videofluoroscopic Swallow Studies: A Professional Manual with Caregiver Guidelines, 1998 (with M. Lefton-Greif, PhD). She has given many presentations on swallowing and feeding disorders in infants and children throughout the world. Patient care, teaching, and research endeavors are focused in these areas.
